Oregon Trail Card:

SSM offers its vendors and customers the opportunity to accept Oregon Trail card for eligible food items through the Market's merchant services. Here is how it works.

- 1. Obtain a 2-part receipt from each vendor listing your eligible products and their booth number.
- 2. Take your receipts to the Information Booth (see Market Map). The staff will process your transactions through the electronic terminal, obtain an approval and stamp each receipt.
- 3. Take your stamped receipts back to the vendor. They will keep the yellow copy and will have your purchases packed and ready to go.

Fruit & Veggie Vouchers (Farm Direct Nutrition Program): Ask the vendor if they can accept these vouchers in payment or partial payment of your vegetables and fruit. To find out which vendors participate in this program, look for signs displayed in their booths or ask at the Information Booth.

FDNP distributes federal funds through vouchers to low-income persons, nutritionally at-risk pregnant women and young children enrolled in the WIC (Women, Infants & Children) program and to eligible low-income seniors and persons with disabilities. These funds can only be used to purchase locally produced, fresh fruit and vegetables at farm stands or farmers' markets directly from authorized farmers through a signed agreement with Department of Agriculture and Department of Human Services.
